YOU DO NOT NEED TO PRINT AND SUBMIT THESE FIRST TWO PAGES. THEY ARE MEANT TO EXPLAIN TO YOU HOW TO PREPARE YOUR SUBMISSION.

Prepare each of the required components. Print pages 3-5 (page 6 is optional) are to be used as a 'Cover Page' to each required component. Please submit, in order, in a portfolio-style folder or thin binder. This will be collected during your scheduled Check In time.

1. Academic Grades or Equivalent Metrics Contestants should submit one or more of the following, depending on their region:

• North America (e.g., U.S., Canada):

• High school transcripts with GPA (e.g., weighted or unweighted).

• Standardized test scores (e.g., SAT, ACT, or AP scores).

• South America (e.g., Brazil, Argentina):

• National or regional exam results (e.g., ENEM in Brazil).

• Europe (e.g., U.K., France, Germany):

• U.K.: Predicted or achieved grades for GCSEs, A-levels, or equivalent.

• Other countries: Grades or diploma certificates (e.g., Abitur in Germany, Baccalauréat in France).

• Africa (e.g., Kenya, Ghana, South Africa):

- Kenya: KCPE (Kenya Certificate of Primary Education) or KCSE (Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education).
- Ghana: BECE (Basic Éducation Certificate Examination) or WASSCE (West African Senior School Certificate Examination).
- South Africa: NSC (National Senior Certificate, also known as "matric").

• Asia (e.g., China, India, Japan):

- China: Gaokao scores (National College Entrance Examination) or high school transcripts.
- India: Board exam results from CBSE, ICSE, or state boards.
- Japan: High school transcripts or Center Test results.

Australia & Oceania:

• Australia: ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admission Rank) or high school transcripts.

Middle East:

• National high school diplomas or Tawjihi (General Secondary Education Certificate).

Guidance for All: If formal documentation is unavailable, contestants can provide a summary of their grading system and key results verified by a teacher or school official.

2. Personal Statement

A short essay (300-500 words) addressing academic goals, achievements, and how education has impacted their aspirations.

3. Extracurricular and Leadership Achievements

Examples may include:

- Participation in academic competitions (e.g., science fairs, Olympiads, debate).
- Leadership roles in school, community, or extracurricular activities.

Volunteer work or impactful projects outside school.

Contestants can submit certificates, awards, or written verification from mentors, teachers, or community leaders.

4. Letters of Recommendation (Optional)

One or two letters from individuals who can speak to the contestant's academic abilities, leadership, and character (e.g., teachers, mentors, or community leaders).
